What is the Straw Race?

Many years ago, a group of well meaning local villagers decided to race through Oxenhope village for charity – “why don't we stop for a beer in each of the pubs on the way?” said one; “let's make it more difficult by carrying a bale of straw?” replied another - and so the Oxenhope Straw Race was born.

Since then, the race has become an annual event and has got bigger but the aim has remained the same: to raise as much as possible for local charities and have fun in the process.

This is not just an event for the determined fun runner and the serious athlete; past years have seen colourful and imaginative entries in the fancy dress categories too. Even for those who do not compete this is a unique family day out with access by steam train, live bands at village pubs and a genuine carnival atmosphere.

Over the years the Straw Race has raised around £300,000 for local charities including Manorlands, The Keighley Resource Centre and many community and youth groups in and around Oxenhope village. On presentation evening each November the competitors and helpers can see how their hard earned cash is used to make a real difference to local people.

Race details

The race is run in teams of two - the cost of entry is £25 per team - teams can be men, ladies or mixed (ladies may carry ½ bales and drink ½ pints).

Teams entered as “athletes” will be given early start times where possible but this cannot be guaranteed.

Teams may enter the veteran’s category if both competitors are over 40.

Registration will take place at the Bay Horse from noon on Saturday 28th June and at the start from 10.30am on Race day – due to possible limited supplies of straw etc., the organisers must reserve the right to refuse late entries submitted on Race day.

The Race starts at 12.00 at the Waggon & Horses, Hebden Bridge Road, Oxenhope.

A free bus service is available on the day from Oxenhope Station to the start and throughout the village during Race day, all kindly donated free of charge by Hodgson’s of Oxenhope.

All roads on the route from the Bay Horse to the Dog & Gun are closed to traffic during the Race.

Sponsorship forms are also available and all competitors are reminded that the main purpose of the Straw Race is to raise much needed funds for some very worthwhile causes so start early and obtain as much sponsorship as possible.
