



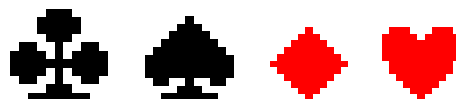

Installing new versions of JAS Bridge Scoring programs

1. Checking for and downloading newer versions

- Open the program (e.g. Pairs Scorer; Teams Scorer; etc) and check the version at the top of the main menu box.
- Go to the JAS website at <http://homepages.nildram.co.uk/~jasmith/> and select "Download".

The JAS Bridge Scoring programs are currently used by the English, Scottish and Welsh Bridge Teams as the scoring software for most of their main tournaments. The Scores are entirely free of charge for Individual, Club or County use, but you may wish to contribute to its maintenance costs via the Donation page.

Program Name	Description
INDSCORER	Individual Score: User-defined or Preset Movement (One or Four Winner) Matchpoint (including US style), Crossimps, (Butler) IMPs, Aggregate or Individual scoring
PAIRSCORER	Pairs Scorer: Howell, Mitchell, Scrambled Mitchell, Individual or a user-defined Preset Movement Neuberg or Simple Matchpoints (including US style), Crossimps, (Butler) IMPs + Capping, Aggregate
TEAMS CORER	Teams Scorer: American Whist (optionally with scorebreak), Stagger Movements or a user-defined Preset Movement
SWISSPAIRSCORER	Swiss Pairs Scorer: Current round or Round-in-Amiears assignments, Matchpointing/Assign Within Sections or Over all Sections, Swiss Pairs, Butler VPs or Butler Imps scoring, Assign Within Sections or Over all Sections
SWISSTEAMSCORER	Swiss Teams Scorer: Current Round assignments, Swiss Teams scoring, English or US style board layout, English or Australian Seating style
BMPTFP	Utility program through which MEDOS scoring programs can interface with the Bridgemate Pro Control Program using the shared Database. It is currently available in an English and German version
BMTEST	Utility program to emulate Bridgemate scoring by inputting random bridge scores into the database shared by the Scorer and BMPro at the users request. This is used for testing
LCPMAN	League/Cup/Plate Result Manager. This has been used by Manchester C&A for several years. It may be customized if there is sufficient demand.

The Scores are reliable, easy-to-use Windows scoring programs for regular Club or County use. They are simple to install and run on any IBM compatible machine. They are designed for robustness, flexibility and ease of use yet fully cater for all the usual requirements of a Bridge Scoring

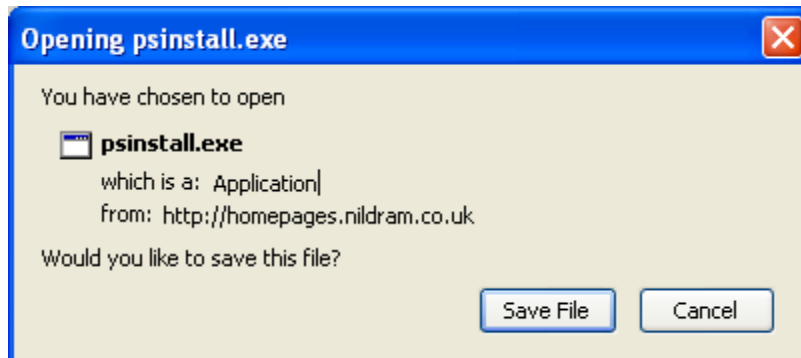

- c. Check the latest version listed and compare with the existing program version.
- d. If a newer version is available, click the “Download” box against the appropriate scoring program.
- e. A download box opens. Check the file name is correct for your program and click “Save File”.

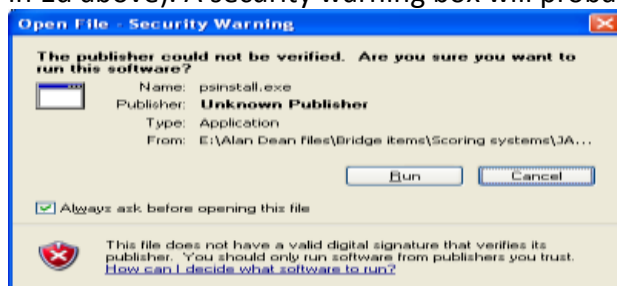


(Pairs Scorer = psinstall.exe; Teams Scorer = tsinstall.exe; Individual Scorer = isinstall.exe; Swiss Pairs Scorer = spsinstall.exe; Swiss Teams Scorer = stsinstall.exe)

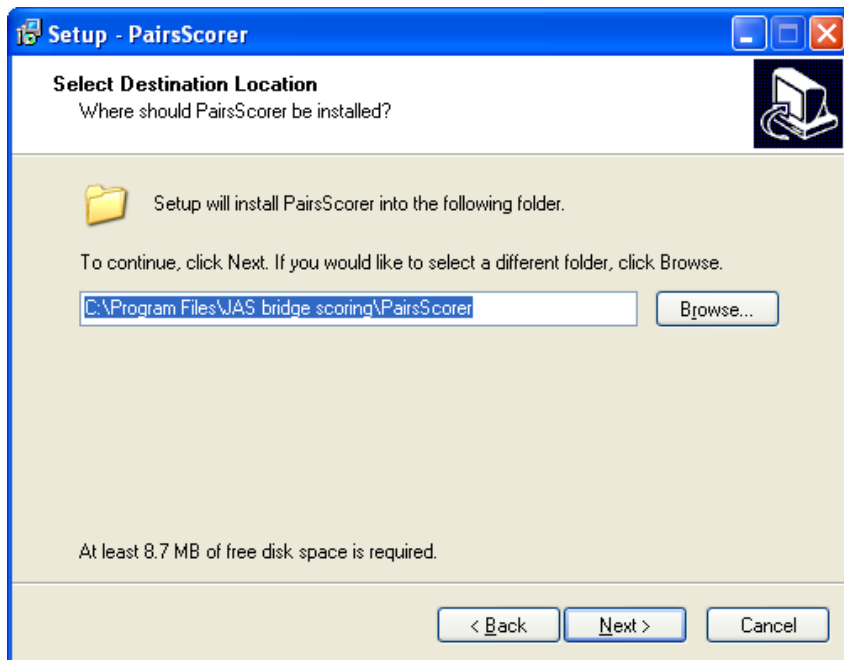
- f. A Windows Explorer box opens showing to save the file in a “Downloads” folder in the “My Documents” folder. Click “Save” to accept and the file will download. If a message appears saying the file already exists, click “Yes” to accept the download.

2. Installing the new version of the program

- a. Click the “Start” button from the desktop, click “My Documents” from the list and double-click “Downloads” folder to open.
- b. Double-click the appropriate program install file (e.g. *psinstall.exe* – see list in 1d above). A security warning box will probably open – click “Run”.



- c. The Setup Wizard will open – click “Next”.
- d. A “Select Location” box will open that should indicate the path for the folder C:\Program Files\JAS bridge scoring\ followed by the name of the program (**Note:** this may vary between computers depending on the path selected for the first installation.)

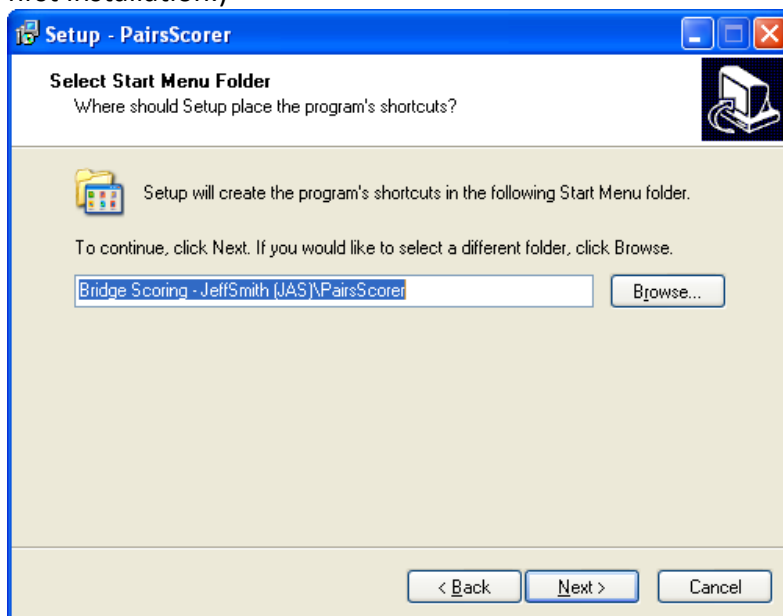


If correct then click “Next”. If a different path is shown, change to the same as the path above, with the appropriate program name left at the end (e.g. PairsScorer; TeamsScorer; etc), then click “Next”.

SPECIAL NOTE FOR VISTA USERS

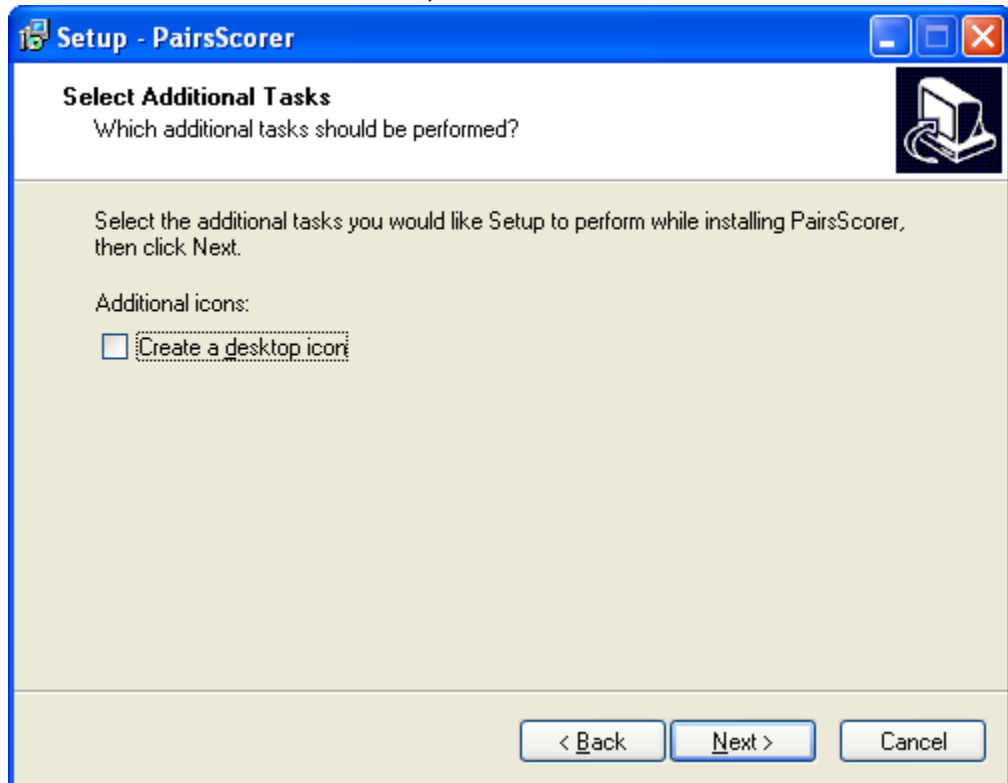
Do not download to C:\program files folder if using VISTA. Vista administers security on that folder differently from previous Windows Operating Systems. Your computer should be set to use the folder C:\JAS bridge scoring instead.

- e. A “Select Start Menu Folder” box will open with a suggested name shown. This should correspond with the existing name on the Start Menu list. (**Note:** this may vary between computers depending on the path selected for the first installation.)

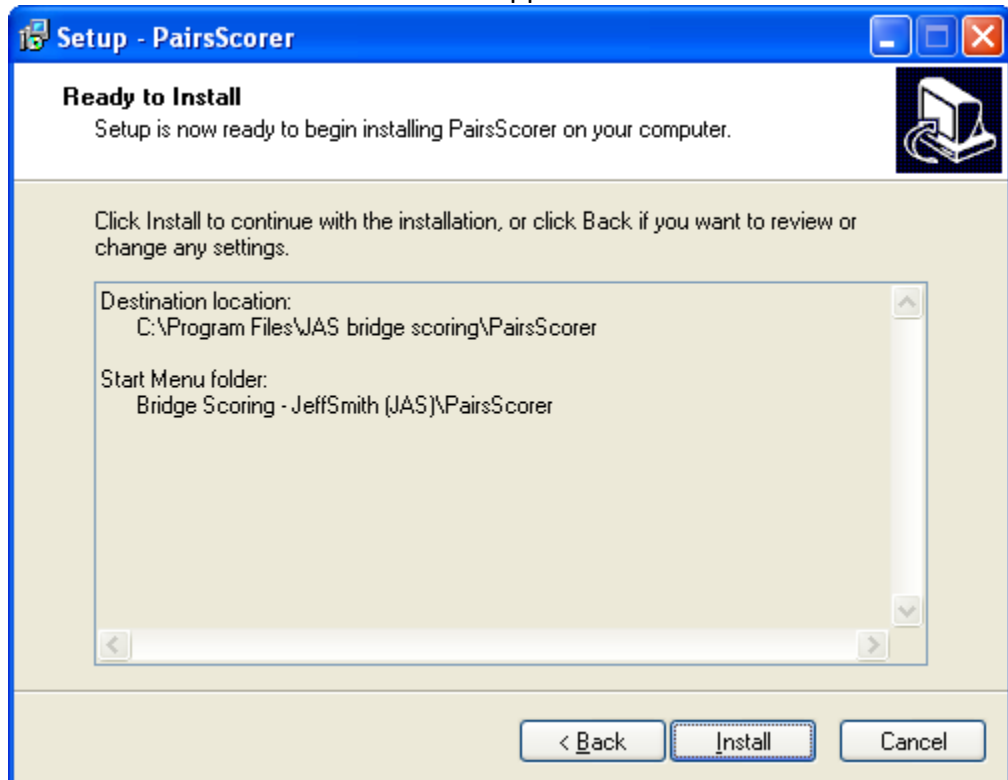


Click “Next”.

- f. The last box will ask whether you want to “Create a desktop icon”. If you do not want a desktop icon or have created a special icon for the program, click the small box to remove the tick, and click “Next”.



- g. The install confirmation box will now appear



Click “Install” and the new program version will load.

- h. The Finish Setup Wizard box will appear with the option to launch the program. Remove the tick by clicking the check box, if you do not wish to run the program.
