

## ***VILLAGE HALL EVENT: COMMUNITY ENERGY & ENERGY EFFICIENCY***

On Friday 23<sup>rd</sup> September, 7-30 pm, there will be a series of talks on the subjects of community energy and energy efficiency which everyone is welcome to attend.

As energy costs continue to spiral upwards there has never been a better time to invest in measures to improve energy efficiency and to reduce reliance on centrally generated energy supplies. Three, Warwickshire based, organisations are providing speakers for the event: -

Community Energy Warwickshire (CEW) Ltd – A new volunteer led social enterprise, set up by people living and working in Warwickshire who want to take positive action to reduce our dependence on fossil fuels. Details will be given of the enterprise and the first of a continuing series of projects in which CEW has teamed up with the NHS to install solar PV panels on roofs at Warwick and Stratford hospitals. This will be followed by details of the community share offer launched to support the enterprise.

Action 21 – A charity based in Leamington devoted to the promotion of sustainable living, has teamed up with solar PV installer, Eco2Solar Ltd, to launch the 'Solar 300' project. The object of which is to install solar panels on 300 houses throughout Warwickshire. Details will be given of the scheme which offers large discounts to groups of five households or more.
